Legal Holiday Observances

Staff wishing to work on this day may do so by advising their departments.

Jewish Holiday Observances

The schedule below lists the days on which the Jewish holidays for 2024 will fall. All Central Administration offices will be closed on those holidays falling on a weekday and employees in Central Administration departments are granted excused time off and are not eligible for additional personal days at any other time during the year. Employees in all other departments who wish to take time off for the Jewish holidays may, with approval of their supervisor, charge the time to accrued personal or vacation days.
