This year, in particular, it is especially important to receive a flu vaccine. The first round of flu vaccine will be dispensed on the following days:

Tuesday, October 6

Wednesday, October 7

Thursday, October 8

9:30-1:30

Lubin Dining Hall

(located in the Block Building on the first floor)

In our ongoing effort to ensure the safety of our community during this time, this vaccine will be available *by appointment only*. Appointments may be made by calling the OHS office at 718-430-2687 or 718-430-2383 between the hours of 9-5. (Since we expect a large volume of phone calls, if the lines are busy, please try your call again at a later time). Individuals who have appointments will be requested to wait outside of Lubin to ensure social distancing. Please arrive no earlier than your appointment time. **Einstein IDs will be required**.

For those employees who receive their insurance through Einstein, please be aware that you may receive the flu vaccine, at no cost to you, in your doctor's office – or receive reimbursement if you use a pharmacy. If you are a member of the 1199 benefit plan, you may also receive the flu vaccine at no additional cost to you at pharmacies where you have your prescriptions filled. You may choose one of these other options if it is more convenient for you.
