I. Tuition and Fees

I.A. Pre-Doctoral Trainees and Fellows

For institutional training grants (T32, T34, T35, T90, TL1) and individual fellowships (F30, F31), an amount per pre-doctoral trainee equal to 60% of the level requested by the applicant institution, up to \$16,000 per year, will be provided. If the trainee or fellow is enrolled in a program that supports formally combined, dual-degree training (e.g., MD/PhD, DO/PhD, DDS/PhD, AuD/PhD, DVM/PhD), the amount provided per trainee or fellow will be 60% of the level requested, up to \$21,000 per year.

(1) Einstein's tuition of \$50,000 exceeds these caps and should be disclosed in all applications, where requested.

Note: Einstein pre-doctoral stipend of \$38,000 became effective 1/1/20 as reflected above.

I.B. Post-doctoral Trainees and Fellows

For institutional training grants (T32, T90, TL1) and individual fellowships (F32, F33), an amount per post-doctoral trainee or fellow equal to 60% of the level requested by the applicant institution, up to \$4,500 per year, will be provided. If the trainee or fellow is enrolled in a program that supports post-doctoral individuals in formal degree-granting training, an amount per postdoctoral trainee or fellow equal to 60% of the level requested by the applicant institution, up to \$16,000 per year, will be provided.

(1) Einstein's tuition of \$50,000 exceeds these caps and should be disclosed in all applications, where requested.

II. Training Related Expenses on Institutional Training Grants

For institutional training grants (T32, T34, T35, T90, TL1), these expenses (including health insurance costs) for pre-doctoral and post-doctoral trainees will be paid at the amounts shown below for all competing and non-competing awards made with FY 2021 funds.

Pre-doctoral Trainees: \$4,200

Health insurance costs reflect an individual/single premium rate. Einstein has limited Health Insurance expense allocation for pre-doctoral Stipends to \$5,302. See breakdown above.

Post-doctoral Trainees: \$11,850. See breakdown above.

Health Insurance expense for Post-doctoral stipends to the single premium rate. Note Health Insurance is now a component of training.
