**Dear Einstein Community:**

We are pleased to announce the appointment of Daniel José Correa, M.D., M.Sc., FAAN, as the fifth associate dean for diversity enhancement at Einstein. Dr. Correa is currently an assistant professor in the Saul R. Korey Department of Neurology at Einstein and assistant chief of neurology at Montefiore Moses Campus, with expertise in epilepsy. In his new role, he will report to Dr. Lynne Holden, senior associate dean for diversity and inclusion.

As associate dean, Dr. Correa will be responsible for developing and running programs for our medical students and participating in our various pathway programs, as well as contributing to establishing future programs. He will also work directly with clinical faculty at our affiliate hospitals regarding student diversity, equity, and inclusion support and clinical career pathway programs.



Dr. Correa received his M.D. from Howard University and completed his residency in neurology at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. After serving as a neurologist in the U.S. Army Medical Corps, he continued his training through the neurophysiology fellowship with Dr. Solomon Moshé and the Comprehensive Epilepsy Center team at Montefiore.

He joined the Einstein faculty in 2017 as a neurophysiologist supporting the epilepsy services at Montefiore and Jacobi. He promptly earned his master's degree from Einstein's Clinical Research Training Program ('19), after which he became a co-leader of the Public Engagement Core of the NIH-funded Epilepsy Bioinformatics Study for Antiepileptogenic Therapy.

Since 2021, Dr. Correa has been chair of neurology's diversity, equity, and inclusion committee. In 2018, the American Academy of Neurology recognized his contributions within diversity by presenting him with its Diversity Leadership Award. In addition to authoring numerous peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters, Dr. Correa hosts the [Brain and Life podcast](#), which can be accessed on the American Academy of Neurology website, and has more than 70 episodes to his credit.
