I. Tuition and Fees

I.A. Predoctoral Trainees and Fellows

For institutional training grants (T32, T34, T35, T90, TL1) and individual fellowships (F30, F31), an amount per predoctoral trainee equal to 60% of the level requested by the applicant institution, up to \$16,000 per year, will be provided. If the trainee or fellow is enrolled in a program that supports formally combined, dual-degree training (e.g., MD/PhD, DO/PhD, DDS/PhD, AuD/PhD, DVM/PhD), the amount provided per trainee or fellow will be 60% of the level requested, up to \$21,000 per year.

(1) Einstein's tuition of \$50,000 exceeds these caps and should be disclosed in all applications, where requested.

Note: The Einstein pre-doctoral stipend of \$50,000 became effective 7/1/2025 as reflected above.

I.B. Postdoctoral Trainees and Fellows

For institutional training grants (T32, T90, TL1) and individual fellowships (F32, F33), an amount per postdoctoral trainee or fellow equal to 60% of the level requested by the applicant institution, up to \$4,500 per year, will be provided. If the trainee or fellow is enrolled in a program that supports postdoctoral individuals in formal degree-granting training, an amount per postdoctoral trainee or fellow equal to 60% of the level requested by the applicant institution, up to \$16,000 per year, will be provided.

(1) Einstein's tuition of \$50,000 exceeds these caps and should be disclosed in all applications, where requested.

II. B. Training Related Expenses on Institutional Training Grants

For institutional training grants (T32, T34, T35, T90, TL1), these expenses (including health insurance costs) for predoctoral and postdoctoral trainees will be paid at the amounts shown below for all competing and non-competing awards made with FY 2024 funds.

Predoctoral Trainees: \$4,750

Health insurance costs reflect an individual/single premium rate. Einstein has limited Health Insurance expense allocation for Pre-doctoral Stipends to \$5,361. See breakdown above.

Postdoctoral Trainees: \$12,400. See breakdown above.

Health Insurance expense for Post-doctoral Stipends to the single premium rate. Note Health Insurance is now a component of Training.
