Ages 18-25; Have aged out of foster care or the juvenile justice system. Working applicants only.</p>

This program also offers a one-time special grant of \$1,800-\$3,600 to cover moving expenses and broker's fees.</p> <p>Individuals between the ages of 18 and 21 and on trial or final discharge to Independent Living.</p>

If you signed yourself out of foster care before your 21st birthday and are now struggling to find a place to live, you should be able to return to your agency if you are still under 21. Talk to your agency and fight to get back into care if that's what you think is best for you.

If you cannot or do not want to return to foster care, and are now struggling to find a place, there are several programs throughout the city that serve youth 18-21 who are homeless or in danger of becoming homeless.
